CERTIFICATE IN MEDICAL ANTHROPOLOGY

The *Certificate in Medical Anthropology* is designed for students seeking expertise in the cross-cultural understanding of health and illness, as well as anthropological perspectives on science and medicine. Courses offer training in medical anthropology, science studies, representations and practices of health and illness, health and identity, and the relationships among gender, race, class, medicine and science.

Requirements:

1. Complete (or expect to complete) three (3) courses by graduation. The following courses are eligible for this certificate:

2. Attain a 3.0 GPA minimum in the three (3) courses that you take to fulfill the requirements for the Certificate program
3. Attend three (3) Anthropology Colloquia and write a 600-800 word report and/or analysis. Summaries will be reviewed and evaluated by the Undergraduate Advisor.
